

Emami Paper commissions its state-of-the-art Multi-layered Paperboard Manufacturing plant in Balasore

Balasore – Odisha, 28th November, 2015: Emami Paper Mills Ltd, part of the Emami Group of Companies, is the largest newsprint manufacturer of the country, has recently diversified into Multi-layered Paperboard production in Balasore, Odisha. A first project of its kind in Eastern Region, the new technologically advanced board machine produces world class packaging boards and is spread over a floor area of approx 50,000 sq.mt. Built with a total investment of around Rs 1000 crores, the new Paperboard manufacturing unit, with a production capacity of 132,000 metric tonnes per annum.

The board unit, which has been commissioned in April 2015, uses 100% imported pulp and recycled fibres. The products produced at this unit include coated folding box boards, solid bleached board (SBS), cup stock board and recycled grey back board. The products would also include 4 layered packaging board, a first in the country.

The new Paperboard manufacturing arm of EMPL has generated direct employment of around 1000 people. The Company, in total, generates a direct and indirect employment of nearly 10,000 people across its units.

Superior German technology and infrastructure of the Paperboard manufacturing unit includes a new board machine, based on the Multi-Fourdrinier technology with four forming fabrics to produce 4 layered boards. The boards produced ensure excellent printing surface by using coating dryers based on 100% IR Heating System. The plant has a state-of-the-art Laboratory equipped with best testing equipments supplied by leading international instrument manufacturers.

Emami Paper has ensured self-sufficiency of power by setting up its own 10.5 MW captive power plant. The total capacity of the captive power plant is 30.5 MW.

The Annual Production of Paperboard in India is 3 million tonne of which high end paperboard accounts for 0.70 mn tonne which itself is growing at an annual growth rate of 15%. The Company is optimistic of the sector's high growth potential which is fuelled by increased consumerism and growth in retail sector. The Newsprint industry is globally facing a degrowth with increased usage of usage of laptops, desktops and smartphones and also due to the cheaper newsprint imports from other countries. The annual growth rate of the newsprint industry currently is around 10%.
