

Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health, UK in association with AMRI Hospitals hosts Diploma Examination in Child Health for the first time in India

The two-day examination was held on 4th & 5th November 2014 in AMRI Hospitals, Mukundapur. The examination, conducted for the first time outside UK, witnessed the participation of 32 Indian doctors aspiring to acquire this coveted qualification from across India. The examination also serves a dual purpose of evaluating the infrastructure that India has to offer for conducting such top grade tests.
